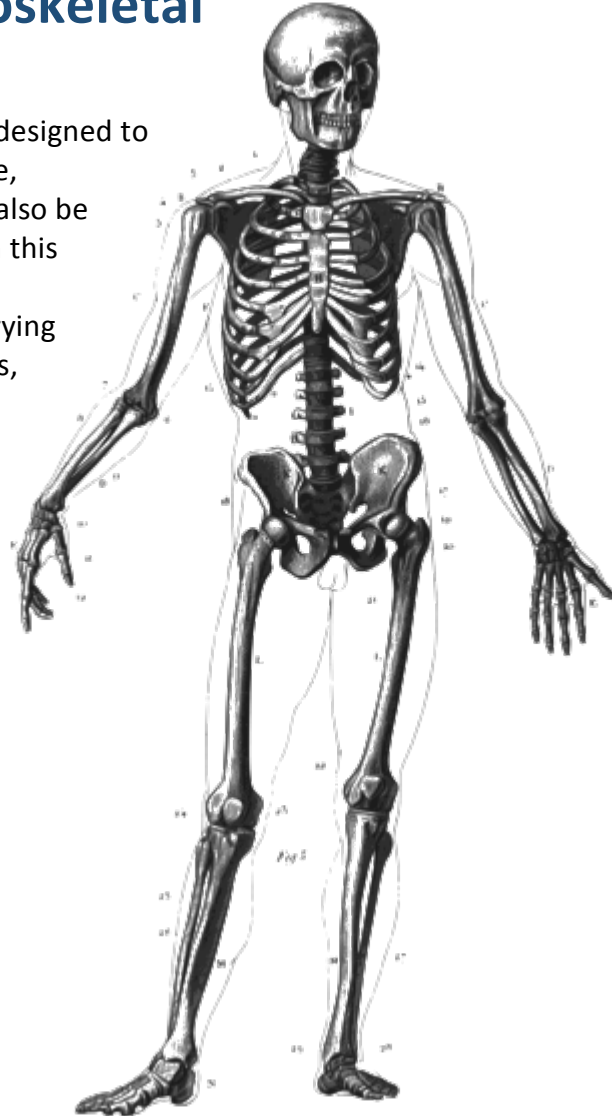


The Integumentary and Musculoskeletal Systems

The Integumentary and Musculoskeletal Systems course is designed to educate students about the skin, soft tissue, skeletal muscle, cartilage and bone. Peripheral nerves and vasculature will also be introduced during this course. Clinical Presentations within this course will represent a variety of symptoms, problems and conditions involving these tissues, organs and systems. Varying conditions such as trauma, infection, autoimmune disorders, neoplasia and other diseases that students are likely to encounter during their clerkships will be included.
