

# SCHEDULING GUIDELINES POLICY

# I. Policy Statement/Purpose

To define the preclinical course contact hours, scheduling, and Holiday time.

## II. Scope/Coverage

This policy applies to ALL CNU College of Medicine Students.

## III. Procedure

The schedule will be as follows:

- A. Holidays: First and second year students receive all University holidays as time off; third and fourth year student schedules will be determined by clerkship directors in conjunction with clinical sites.
- B. There should be an average of 24 contact hours maximum per week during the preclinical courses (Phase A).
- C. There should be a 10 minute break between classes.
- D. Class sessions 2 hours or longer should incorporate a 10 minute break for student/faculty wellness for every hour of instruction.
- E. Medical Skills should have 15 minute break between each group.
- F. The following courses will have a final summative exam:
  - 1. All Phase A courses
  - 2. All required core clerkships
- G. Lunch will be 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM every day.
